Burlington Ontario Early Years Winter Drop-in Programs January 9 – February 25, 2012

Drop-in programs are available for children newborn to 6 years of age. The maximum number of children per adult (over 16 years of age) is 5 children plus their own.

- ☺ Please sign in and make yourself and your child(ren) a nametag. Name tags make communication easier, and we would like to get to know you by name.
- ☺ Please be aware that the doors to drop in close 15 minutes before the end of each program. Please sign out on the drop-in sheet when you leave, by indicating with a check mark or initials.
- ☺ Support and interact with children, socialize, relax, laugh, but keep an active eye on your children at all times. Please be aware of adult content in your conversations as we are a family-oriented setting.
- ☺ A snack area and time may be provided. Check specific site accommodations. Please consume all food and drinks at the tables and highchairs provided. Please clean up the area your family used with the supplied disinfectant solution.
- ☺ All Burlington OEYC locations are nut-free. We ask that you check the list of contents of any foods brought into any location to ensure that no nuts have been used in the processing of your food items! Although we endeavour to make the Centres nut-free, be aware that we cannot guarantee that everyone follows our guidelines.
- ☺ Positive discipline techniques will be used. Redirection and problem solving techniques are used within the Centres. Children learn best from positive role modeling. Physical or verbal punishment is not permitted.
- ☺ ALL children must be accompanied by an adult in the washroom.
- ☺ While visiting the centre throughout the year, shoes or rubber- soled slippers must be worn at all times for health and safety reasons. Please wipe your wet shoes/boot before entering the centre.
- ☺ It is the adult's responsibility to supervise their child(ren) at the creative tables.
- ☺ If you need to change a diaper please use the change tables in the washrooms and follow the posted Diaper Change Procedures to eliminate the transfer of germs.
- ☺ We discourage children from bringing toys from home into the Centres. We are not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- ☺ All toys and costumes are to be kept out/off of the large muscle equipment (ie. Climbers, campers, etc.)
- ☺ Please place any toys your child has mouthed in the "Chewy Bins" located at all sites. These toys are disinfected daily.
- ☺ Once Drop-in reaches capacity, a CLOSED sign with alternate Drop-in locations will be posted on the front door until the numbers decrease. Capacity is decided by both Fire Code at each location and the lead ECE's determination of the safety and activity level in the playroom.
- ☺ Please contact the staff if any injury occurs to your child(ren) or yourself. An injury report will be filled out by the staff member with the cooperation of the adult.
- ☺ In order to protect the health of our families and staff, we ask that you not attend the Centres if you or your child(ren) are feeling ill.
