

Do you need some time just for you?

Our new ROCK Kids Club program provides a great opportunity for your child(ren) to participate in a variety of activities, including sensory activities, songs, stories, arts, games and free play, while parents and caregivers take some time for themselves.

Kids Club Registration must be made in person at our Cumberland Early Years Centre (710 Cumberland Ave). Limited spaces are available. First-come, first served. Payment by cash or cheque must be received with registration. Cheques should be made payable to Reach Out Centre for Kids. Refunds are only available if requested one week prior to the start of your session. A \$25 administration fee will apply. No refunds can be provided after this time. Spaces in this program are non-transferrable.

What to Bring With You

Please provide a backpack each week clearly labeled with your child's name and the following items inside.

Clothing

Children should wear comfortable clothing. Each child should have an extra set of clothing including underwear, socks, T-shirt, pants and an indoor pair of shoes. All creative supplies are non-toxic, safe and washable, but not all stains wash out!

Diapers

We do not expect that all children are toilet trained, so if necessary please provide spare diapers and wipes for your child. Children will be toileted on demand and during the morning washroom routine. If your child needs their diaper changed outside this routine it will be attended to.

Snack

Please send a nut-free snack for your child. All snacks should be labeled with your child's name.

Arrival and Pick-up

When you arrive, you will be required to sign your child in to the program and indicate who will be picking up your child at departure time. When you pick-up your child, you must see a staff member to sign your child out. In the interest of safety, we cannot allow a child to leave the classroom with someone we do not know. Your child will only be released to those people designated on your registration form. When the individual picking up your child is listed on your form, but not known to staff, Photo ID will be required before we can release your child.

Allergies and Administration of Medication

The Centre will not administer any medication except in the event a child requires emergency medication in response to an allergic, asthmatic or life threatening condition. If your child has an epi- pen or puffer, please contact the Program Manager to complete the proper forms.

Health Care Policies

Parents are required to keep their child at home if they display any of the following:

- Fever (anything over 38.5 C)
- Respiratory symptoms
- Diarrhea/vomiting
- Eye/Nose drainage- thick mucus or pus draining
- Sore throat
- Itching (persistent of body or scalp)
- Head lice

In the event that your child should become ill during a program, the parents will be called first and then, if the parents cannot be reached, we will call the emergency contact to pick up your child. Parents will not be reimbursed for absences due to illness.

Inclement Weather & Closures

This program will be cancelled if the Halton District School Board closes schools for the Burlington area due to weather conditions. Parents will not be reimbursed for cancellations due to weather conditions.

Returned Cheques

Cheques should be made payable to Reach Out Centre for Kids. Any cheques that are returned by your bank (NSF, etc.) are subject to a \$20.00 administration fee.
